#### **2011 Public Service Award Request for Nominations**

The Harvard Club of Washington DC is requesting nominations for the 2011 Public Service Award (PSA). The HCW awarded the first PSA in 2000, in memory of the late Elliot L. Richardson, '40, LLB '47, LLD '72, who exemplified public service. The award is presented annually to an individual who attended or has been affiliated with Harvard University, made significant contributions to the public good, and whose service has at least in part been focused on the Washington, DC area. While current or former elected officials have been among those considered as potential recipients of the PSA, the "public good" is not limited to government service. The Harvard Club has presented the PSA to individuals whose contributions are in areas as diverse as government service, social entrepreneurship, the arts, and journalism.

- The nominee's name and Harvard affiliation;
- A one page statement describing the nominee's contribution to public service as well as the significance and impact of that contribution;
