

The Club's largest volunteering activity is Schools Committee. Each year, over 300 graduates of the Harvard College interview candidates from the greater Washington area -- which spans from the far reaches of Loudoun County in Virginia down to Solomon's Island in southern Maryland. In 2010-11, we were able to offer every applicant to Harvard from our area an interview. In total, Schools Committee interviewed over 1,000 applicants from this area. In addition, Schools Committee members volunteer at college fairs throughout the area, and give presentations on Harvard, as well as the college preparation and application processes more generally, at high schools across our area.

We have just finished interviewing Early Action applicants for the 2011-12 year, and we are still looking for additional interviewers for the Regular Action period, which continues into March.
